ALL OF THE B&B ROOMS HAVE THEIR OWN BATHROOM (AT LEAST A TOILET AND SINK) AND MANY HAVE SHOWERS AND/OR TUBS. THE SPECIAL NA GROUP RATES FOR THE B&B ROOMS ARE \$80+ TAX/SINGLE, \$100+ TAX/DOUBLE. THERE ARE ALSO TWENTY ONE GUEST ROOMS SOME OF WHICH HAVE A HALF BATH AND SOME WHICH SHARE THE BATHROOM DOWN THE HALL. SPECIAL NA RATES FOR GUEST ROOMS ARE: \$60+ TAX/SINGLE AND \$80+ TAX/DOUBLE. EXTRA ADULTS IN A ROOM ARE \$10 PER PERSON, AND CHILDREN AGES 5 -12 IN A ROOM ARE \$4 EXTRA. CAMPING IN TENTS, CARS OR RVs IS \$5 PER NIGHT PER PERSON.
